student exchange program

BEFOREHAND:

If you have a UGA exchange agreement, identify the host faculty using the disciplines taught by faculty in the course catalog.

EXCEPTIONS: In order to exchange students with: Medicine, the CUEF, and UGA's three autonomous educational institutions, Sciences Po Grenoble, Institut Polytechnique de Grenoble and Ecole Nationale Supérieure d'Architecture de Grenoble, you need to set up a specific student exchange agreement.

APPLICATION PROCESS





Nominated students will automatically receive an application email upon their nomination.

The required documents are:

- · All academic transcript of records
- Curriculum vitae
- · Any language test or a certificate of language. Please check that the language level required by the host faculty is respected either in French and/or English.
- Student's motivations
- · Learning Agreement UGA (or ERASMUS+ provided by the home university) completed in accordance with the rules defined by the

The home university determines the number of credits that can be taken, up to a maximum of 30 credits per semester.
