The **Zimmermann lab** at the **Würzburg Institute of Systems Immunology** invites applications for an ERC-funded PhD position in immunology in the topic of microbiota-directed T cell responses.

Join our young and enthusiastic team in our **ERC-funded endeavor** to understand how the **gut microbiota** induces **T cell responses** and how this can go wrong in inflammatory bowel disease. To achieve this, we use cutting edge germ-free mouse technology including newly developed models of transient bacterial colonization. We combine these with state-of-the-art immunological tools, such as adoptive transfers and peptide:MHC tetramers, to be able to follow specific T cells over time and across organs (*Zimmermann et al., manuscript in preparation*).
